Transportation

Taxi

At Hongqiao International Airport (SHA) or Pudong International Airport (PVG), taxis are available at any time. You can go to the Airport Taxis Stand, give the address where you are going, and they give you a voucher with cost of the transportation.

A trip from Pudong International Airport to the hotel should be around 180.00 CNY, while from Hongqiao International Airport should be around 75.00 CNY.

Subway

You can also take subway to the hotel from airports.

- From Hongqiao International Airport to the hotel
From Hongqiao Airport Terminal 1 Station or Hongqiao Airport Terminal 2 Station to Guoquan Road Station by Metro Line 10
Walk 10 minutes to the hotel
- From Pudong International Airport to the hotel
From Pudong Airport Station to East Nanjing Road Station by Metro Line 2
Transfer to Metro Line 10 to Guoquan Road Station
Walk 10 minutes to the hotel
