

2023/24 CAMPUS Asia Plus Winter Short Program Graduate School of International Studies (GSIS) Korea University (KU)

1. Overview

Since 2015, the KU GSIS CAMPUS Asia Plus Program has been providing its Winter Short Program for graduate students from partner schools. In this program, students can choose between two different programs – Language and Culture Fellowship Program & Research Fellowship Program. The Language and Culture Fellowship Program participants can benefit from the Korean language courses, special lectures on risk management and field trips that allow participants to experience Korean culture and Korean history. Students joining the Research Fellowship Program can conduct their academic research and present their studies at the end of the Program, with access to special lectures.

2. Application Requirements

Participants must be graduate students at Fudan University, Kobe University, Chulalongkorn FON or NUOL FEB, and must be Chinese, Japanese, Thai or Lao nationals.

3. Schedule: February 15 – February 28, 2023

The KU GSIS Winter Short Program of the year 2023/24 will take place from February 15 to February 28, totaling 14 days (including the weekends) which will be distributed to diverse activities including the Korean language courses, special lectures on risk management, field trips and individual time to be used for research. Detailed information about the special lectures will be shared later.

4. Costs and Funding

The Language and Culture Fellowship which will cover tuition fees for the KU Korean Language Center, special lectures, most program activities and access to the KU Library.

Alternatively, the Research Fellowship will include access to KU Library, and participants can attend special lectures for free.

Students are expected to cover their own expenses for categories listed below and the amount of the actual expenditure will depend on a number of factors including the accommodation choice, personal spending habits and currency exchange rates.

- International airfare (Lao students may receive financial support for airfare please contact the CAMPUS Asia office in your university in case you're a Lao applicant)
- Ground transportation
- Meals
- Personal expenditures, communication, course materials, etc.
