1. Theme

Kobe University Secondary School SGH Program "Earthquake disaster, reconstruction and risk management"

2. Purpose

- (2) Visit the disaster areas and listen to the stories of the victims. Think about what we should do to share the story to the future generations.
- (3) Approach to the earthquakes from the humanities and natural sciences point of view. Students will experience a drilling investigation to find tsunami sediments.
- (4) Working together as a team, all students should learn how to care and help others.
